NOTIFICATION

No. SRO 886(I)/87 ^{dt-4/11/87}. In pursuance of sub-rule (2) of rule 3 of the Civil Servants (Appointment, Promotion and Transfer) Rules, 1973, the following method, qualifications and other conditions are laid down for appointment to the post of Deputy Director, Town Planning, BPS-19 in Military Lands and Cantonments Department under Defence Division.

METHOD OF APPOINTMENT.

2. Initially appointment to the post shall be made by promotion of Town Planner (BPS-18) and there-after the post shall be filled by initial appointment.

CONDITIONS FOR PROMOTION.

3. Promotion to post in column 1 below shall be made by selection from amongst the person who hold the post specified in column 2 on a regular basis, and possesses the qualifications and experience prescribed in column 3:-

Deputy Director Town Planning (BPS-19).	Town Planner (BPS-18).	7 years experience as Town Planner (BPS-18) with relevant field.

QUALIFICATIONS, EXPERIENCE AND AGE LIMITS FOR
INITIAL APPOINTMENT.

4. A candidate must possess the educational qualification and experience and must be within the age limits as mentioned against the post concerned in the Schedule to this notification.

Provided that the maximum age limit will be relaxed by 3 years in the case of candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes, Buddhist Community, recognised tribes of the Tribal Areas, Azad Kashmir and Northern Areas (Districts of Gilgit, Skardu and Diamir) in accordance with the instructions issued by the Establishment Division.

Provided further that for Government servants who have completed at least 2 years continuous Government service, maximum age limit may be relaxed by not more than 10 years upto the age of 55 years, wherever applicable.

PROBATION.

5. Persons appointed by promotion or initial appointment shall be on probation for a period of one year. This period may be curtailed for good and sufficient reasons to be recorded or if considered necessary, it may be extended for a period not exceeding one year as may be prescribed at the time of appointment. Appointment on probation shall be subject to the provisions of section 6 of Civil Servants Act, 1973.

6. This Notification issues with the concurrence of the Establishment Division and Federal Public Service Commission vide O.M. No.4/9/86-R-5, dated 24th March, 1987 and letter No.F.12-25/87-S, dated 28.9.87 and supersedes Ministry of Defence's Notification No.SRO 66(KE)/74, dated 31.7.1974.
